Dear Robin:

Since you will not be sending your Womens Rights Handbook through the mail the identification requirement outlined in Section 84305 of the Government Code is not applicable. You may, however, be required to comply with the provisions of the Elections Code Section 29410 which covers all material having reference to an election other than mass mailings covered by the Political Reform Act. So I would suggest you either contact your local district attorney or the Attorney General's Office (Scott Thorpe, 916/445-6808) for information concerning identification requirements under the Elections Code.

In response to your second question, an assembly candidate is a candidate for state office and therefore, all mass mailings sent by the candidates or committees supporting or opposing a state candidate must be sent to the Commission.

It was very good to hear from you. I hope you will let me know if I can be of assistance in the future.
