Subject: Filing Pursuant to Government Code Section
81005(b)

At the January 4, 1978, Opinion Request meeting, staff concluded that a controlled committee of a candidate specified in Government Code Section 81005(b) may choose to file, under that section, two copies of its campaign statements with either the clerk of the county in which the candidate resides or the clerk of the county in which the committee is domiciled. The committee must also file the original and one copy with the Secretary of State and two copies with the clerk of the largest county which in whole or in part is included in the candidate's election district.

However, if a candidate, specified in Government Code Section 81005(b), and her/his controlled committee filed a consolidated campaign statement, under Government Code Section 84213, that choice would not be available to them. Two copies of a consolidated campaign statement must be filed with the clerk of the county in which the candidate resides and the clerk of the county in which the committee is domiciled. The consolidated campaign statement must be filed in as many locations as necessary to satisfy the obligations of both the candidate and the committee.
