Subject: Interpretation of "second preelection campaign statement"

At the May 8, 1978, Opinion Request meeting, it was decided that the intent of Government Code Section 91013 (a) and (b) was such that the five day time limit should also apply to written notices sent in the case of a campaign statement required to be filed 12 days prior to the special, general or runoff election under Government Code Section 84203.

There was discussion about the desirability of a legislative amendment to change the reference in Government Code Section 91013(a) and (b) from "second preelection campaign statement" to "campaign statement required to be filed twelve days before the election." Bob Stern later indicated he did not favor such an amendment.
