Greetings:

County central committees vary greatly. The questions below arise from some of these variations.

1. Names of "potential" central committee candidates are omitted from the ballot when the number of candidates does not exceed the number of positions to be filled;- what are the reporting requirements for "potential" candidates whose names do not appear on the ballot? No election occurs for such persons; there is no balloting or tabulation of votes; there is no "primary" election for such persons.

2. Is a report required for a county central committee in a year in which the following are all true?


- a. it's income is less than \$500,
- b. it's expenditures are less than \$500,
- c. no contributor has contributed as much as \$50.

3. If reports are required from such committees as in "2" above,

- a. are they required in "off" election years?
- b. what are the most suitable forms to use?
