Dear Mr. Sanchez:

This letter is in response to your letter to the Commission dated January 19, 1978 regarding the disposition of surplus funds by a committee.

You have inquired as to whether there are any restrictions on how surplus funds of the committee may be disposed of. The Political Reform Act does not place any restriction on the disposition of surplus funds; however, a committee that receives contributions of \$500 or more in a calendar year is required to file a Statement of Organization pursuant to Government Code Section 84102, and include a description of how surplus funds will be disposed of in the event of dissolution. Whenever there is a change in any information contained in the Statement of Organization, including the description of how surplus funds will be disposed of, an amendment is required to be filed within 10 days to reflect the change. If you cannot recall what you stated on the Statement of Organization at the time you filed with the Secretary of State's Office, you may either call or write the Secretary of State, P.O. Box 1467, Sacramento 95807 or 916/322-4880 and they will be able to give you that information from the original document. If you dispose of your surplus funds and do not anticipate any additional activity concerning this fund you should send a termination statement to the Secretary of State's Office.

Enclosed for your use and information is a termination form and fact sheet which outlines the conditions under which a committee may terminate. I trust this information will be of assistance to you. Please let me know if you require additional information.
