Subject: Advice pertaining to Sections 84201, 84206 and 84214

This memo will confirm advice given to the Technical Assistance Division concerning contributions made to candidates or committees by officeholders or candidates not involved in the election to which the contribution was made.

An officeholder or candidate making a contribution to a candidate or committee involved in an election need not file campaign statements in connection with the election unless<sup>ing</sup> contributing officeholder or candidate is also involved in the election.

An officeholder or candidate not involved in an election to which he/she makes a late contribution need not report the contribution within 48 hours. Contributions outlined above must be included on the next semi-annual or campaign statement in connection with an election the contributing candidate or officeholder is required to file.

This advice does not apply to any controlled committee of an officeholder or candidate which may make contributions. Committees are required to file campaign statements in connection with contributions made in a primary or general election in even numbered years regardless of the amount and must file in connection with special or local elections when contributing \$250 or more to any candidate or committee.
