Dear Ms. Wallace:

This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of March 7, 1979.

The question you posed was whether or not a penalty that has been assessed a committee included the date of the postmark of that campaign statement that was mailed, or the date that your office actually received the campaign statement?

I advised that the penalty should include and end on the date of the postmark of the mailed campaign statement. The same principal that is used for campaign statements which are mailed must be postmarked by no later than midnight of the date on which the campaign statement is due is applicable. This advice has been confirmed by Barbara Campbell of our Legal Division in Sacramento. I have enclosed a copy of a factsheet which the Commission has developed for the filing of campaign statements by mail (Government Code Section 81007) for your information.
