Dear Mr. Dunn:

This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of March 7, 1979 concerning the itemization of contributions received from churches in excess of \$100.

Government Code Section 84210(g) specifies in part that... "the full name of each person from whom a contribution or contributions totaling one hundred dollars (\$100) or more has been received, together with his street address, occupation, and the name of his employer, if any, or the principal place of business if he is self-employed, the amount he contributed, the date on which each contribution was received during the period covered by the campaign statement, and the cumulative amount he contributed."

Therefore, if a contribution of \$100 or more is received and drawn on a church's account, the church has to be itemized as the donor on the recipient committee's campaign report.
