The Fair Political Practices Commission's Regulation 18419 allows for all of the political activity of your local which would otherwise be reportable under the law to be included on the campaign statements filed by the Service Employees International Union.

I would suggest that you forward a copy of the regulation (I have enclosed a copy for your convenience) to the Washington D.C. office so they may know exactly what is required to be reported on their statements.
