Dear Assemblywoman Hallett:

Thank you for your letter of March 28, 1980 (which was not postmarked until April 8th) in which you ask me to prepare a suggested response to a constituent's inquiry. I can only answer her first question; the second question should be directed to the Secretary of State, the Attorney General or the Morro Bay City Attorney:

"In response to your inquiry about the Citizens Action League, I have enclosed a copy of its Statement of Organization which is on file at the Secretary of State's office in Sacramento. This Statement lists the officers of the group as well as its purposes.

If the Citizens Action League spent at least \$500 on the ballot measures which were before the Morro Bay electorate, it was required to file campaign statements with the Morro Bay city clerk twice before the election. These campaign statements will itemize contributions of \$100 or more as well as expenditures of \$100 or more.

Finally, if the group were the proponent of the measures, it also was required by law to file campaign statements after the completion of the circulation of the measures.

Copies of these campaign statements may be examined at the city clerk's office or may be purchased for \$.10 a page."

PERTINENT FACTS AND DESCRIPTION OF PROBLEM:

RE: Citizens Action League

1)

Mrs. Hempenius wants to know how to obtain data on this group. She would like to find out if this is a state or a national organization which may be placing people in an area for the purpose of electing? She has questioned members of the group and they have been "very close-mouthed." There are 500 members in Morro Bay. She recently saw an ad in a San Francisco paper which was advertising for membership. She finds this "frightening in its implications. The control they are gathering is formidable."

On the upcoming April ballot, there are two measures, A and B, which were initiated, constructed, signatures gathered, and it was placed on the ballot by CAL people *Citizens Action League*

2)

Measure A: Deals with expenditures of bed tax. It limits and regulates this tax for community promotion. She has investigated and would like to know how this measure can be on the ballot when the California Landlords and Tenants Law and Procedure Book states (page 17) that when a general law city, (as Morro Bay is), only the City Council has authority to deal with room occupancy tax. The state law is clear as to how and by whom this tax is to be handled.

On Measure B: Ordinance requiring no annexation of territory without a general or special election of the people. She has called

Barbara, Administrative assistant of LAFCO, asking for clarification of annexation laws. She was told "they are cut and dried as to annexation of lands." It is "very specific" in its definitions, and involves only those parties who own the land or are immediately adjacent, and the city. This is not a general public issue to be placed before the voters. She contends this measure is not legal, so "How did it get on the ballot?"

Mrs. Hempenius would like to know who has the final authority to place this on the ballot? She can find no answers, would like CH to assist.
