- Treasury bills

- Federal and military pensions

The Political Reform Act does not require interests in a diversified mutual fund registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission, or any bond or other debt instrument issued by any government or government agency to be reported (see Government Code Section 82034).

Also, the Commission staff has determined that Treasury bills would be exempt from disclosure since they would be considered a debt instrument issued by the government.
