Dear Mike,

This letter is sent to confirm telephone advice I gave you concerning the application of Government Code Section 89001<sup>1/</sup> to Senator Johnson.

Senator Johnson is seeking reelection this year. He is an Independent, and, as such, he does not run in the primary election. Since he is not on the primary ballot, he is not required to file a declaration of candidacy pursuant to Election Code Section 6490 in the early spring. After the primary, he will file a declaration of candidacy with a requisite number of signatures to run as an Independent in the November General Election. Senator Johnson is in the process of preparing several mass mailings for his district including his newsletter. Accordingly, you asked on what date the mass mailing prohibition in Section 89001 applies to Senator Johnson.

Section 89001 prohibits elected state officers from sending legislative newsletters or other mass mailings at public expense after the elected state officer has filed a declaration of candidacy for any office. According to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's Office, Senator Johnson must file a declaration of candidacy between June 11, 1984, and August 10, 1984, in order to run as an Independent in the November 1984 General Election. Accordingly, the prohibition in Section 89001


