Dear Ms. Rutland:


This will confirm our telephone conversation of this date regarding implementation of the amended provisions of Government Code Section 89001 restricting the use of newsletters and mass mailings by elected public officials.

The "nomination documents" referred to in 89001(a), which applies to incumbent members of the State assembly, means all documents necessary to have a candidate's name printed on the ballot.

The Commission has noticed amendments to 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18902 to codify this interpretation. A copy of the noticed regulation is enclosed. It will be considered at the Commission's hearing on April 5, 1988, in Sacramento.
