Dear Mr. Luking:


On March 25, 1988, we received your letter requesting a copy of our organic statute and our rules and regulations.

The Political Reform Act <sup>1/</sup> was an initiative on the 1974 ballot. It was passed overwhelmingly by the voters. The Political Reform Act was established for several purposes, some of which are disclosure of sources of campaign contributions, disclosure of assets and income of public officials, disqualification of public officials from decisions which could affect their private financial interests, and regulation of the activities of lobbyists to prevent improper influences on public officials. A copy of the Act is enclosed.

The regulations which implement the Political Reform Act can be ordered through the Department of General Services, Documents Section, P.O. Box 1015, North Highlands, CA 95660. To order the regulations, you cite Title 2, Division 6 of the California Code of Regulations. There is an \$8 base fee and a \$12 subscription fee to keep the regulations current.

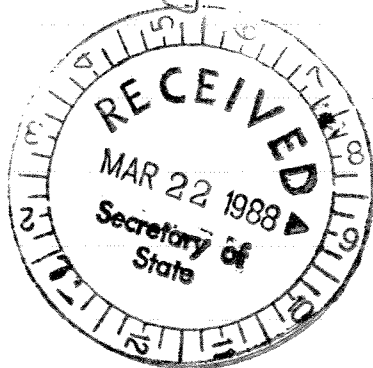
