Dear Ms. Carr:

You have requested confirmation of telephone advice provided to you concerning the conflict of interest disclosure provisions of the Political Reform Act.^{1/}

Your letter, dated March 22, 1990, correctly summarizes my advice that Mr. Bedwell and Mr. Richert may each combine their 1989 annual statements of economic interests with their leaving office statements. The period covered by each statement will be January 1, 1989, through the date the filer left office. For Mr. Reichert, the closing date will be February 21, 1990. Mr. Bedwell's closing date will be February 15, 1990, the last day he was authorized to act as city manager.

Your new city manager, Jan Dolan, will be required to file her first annual statement on April 1, 1991, covering the period January 16, 1990 through December 31, 1990.

A copy of your letter is enclosed for your convenience.


