Dear Ms. Huntly:

This to confirm advice provided to you on May 10, 1990, regarding the campaign disclosure provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This letter constitutes written advice under Section 84205, which states:

The Commission may by regulation or written advice permit candidates and committees to file campaign statements combining statements and reports required to be filed by this title.

A ballot measure election has been scheduled for July 24, 1990 in the city of Turlock. Because the first and second pre-election statements due in connection with the election (Section 84200.8) and the semi-annual statement due for the first six months of 1990 (Section 84200) cover almost identical periods, we believe it is appropriate for committees primarily formed to support or oppose the measure to combine those reports. Therefore, campaign statements in connection with the July 24, 1990, election should be filed on the following schedule:

<u>Type of Statement</u>	<u>Period Covered</u>	<u>Filing Deadline</u>
1st Pre-Election for July election	Jan. 1 - June 9	June 14
2nd Pre-Election for July election	June 10 - July 7	July 12
Semi-Annual	July 8 - Dec. 31	January 31, 1991

Committees not involved in the July 24, 1990 election will not use this filing schedule, but will use the regular dates set out in the "Information Manual on Campaign Disclosure Provisions of the Political Reform Act."
