This is in response to your letter of October 30, 1990, regarding your participation in committee meetings consisting of less than a quorum of the members of the Cathedral City Redevelopment Agency. You are a city councilmember and a member of the redevelopment agency.

A review of these materials indicates that your request does not present a question under the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ Since our jurisdiction extends only to matters covered by the Act, we cannot provide you with assistance regarding these matters. Therefore we suggest you consult with the Attorney General's office, which has jurisdiction over the Brown Act. (Section 54950, et seq.)
