Dear Mr. Lemmon:

You have requested confirmation of telephone advice provided to you concerning the conflict of interest disclosure provisions of the Political Reform Act.^{1/}

Your letter of November 22, 1991, accurately summarizes the advice provided. The CA-NV Super Speed Ground Transportation Commission expires on January 1, 1992. However, legislation may be signed by the Governor which would extend the Commission for another year. If the legislation is signed, the members will file annual Statements of Economic Interests (Form 730) due no later than April 1, 1992. However, if the legislation is not signed, the members must file combined annual and leaving office statements, due within 30 days of the termination of the Commission.


