Dear Ms. Brett:

This is in response to your request for confirmation of telephone advice concerning the campaign provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹

On May 21, 1992, the Committee to Elect Ken Duran made an expenditure in the amount of \$1,700 for the preparation of a mailer in support of the committee's controlling candidate, Ken Duran. The expenditure was made during the 16 days immediately preceding the election in which the candidate was being voted on. This letter will confirm my advice to you that an expenditure made out of campaign funds by a candidate's controlled committee on behalf of the candidate is not required to be reported within 24 hours of making the expenditure. The expenditure must be reported on the next regular campaign report that the committee would be required to file.
