Dear Justice Peterson:

You have requested confirmation of telephone advice concerning the conflict of interest disclosure requirements of the Political Reform Act. (Government Code Sections 81000-91015.)

Your letter dated October 5, 1992, correctly summarizes my advice. Because there was no break in service from your position as Associate Justice, Division Two, and your appointment to Presiding Justice, Division Five, of the Court of Appeal and the jurisdiction for both offices remains the same, you are not deemed to have assumed office or left office. (Government Code Section 87205.) Therefore, your next filing obligation will be your 1992 annual Statement of Economic Interests covering the period January 1, 1992 through December 31, 1992. Your annual statement is due no later than March 1, 1993.
