You have requested confirmation of telephone advice provided to you on October 23, 1992, concerning the campaign provisions of the Political Reform Act.^{1/}

This letter will confirm my advice that the Santa Monica Republican Club will not qualify as a slate mailer organization if it pays for a mailing from the Club's general treasury that endorses several candidates. Depending upon the specific facts, the mailing will qualify as an independent expenditure and/or a contribution and may trigger the filing of either a late independent expenditure report or a late contribution report.
