Dear Ms. Wechsler:

This is to confirm telephone assistance provided to you on behalf of Senator David Roberti concerning the campaign disclosure provisions of the Political Reform Act.^{1/} This letter constitutes written advice under Section 84205, which states:

The Commission may by regulation or written advice permit candidates and committees to file campaign statements combining statements and reports required to be filed by this title.

Senator Roberti is the subject of a recall election which will be held April 12, 1994. In addition, he is a potential candidate for the Office of California State Treasurer. The primary election for the Office of State Treasurer will be held June 7, 1994. Because the second pre-election statement filing period for the April 12th election will overlap with the first pre-election statement filing period for the June 7th election, we believe it is appropriate for Senator Roberti and his controlled committees to file campaign disclosure statements on the following schedule:
