Dear Mr. Saar:

You have requested information concerning the Commission's investigatory procedure and administrative enforcement process. You have specifically asked about the Commission's stand on the use of public monies in political campaigns and the use of official titles by individuals in campaigns.

The Fair Political Practices Commission is empowered to administer the provisions of the Political Reform Act (copy enclosed). You will note that Section 85300 governs the use of public monies in political campaigns and Sections 91000 et seq. set out our enforcement authority. Also enclosed is a copy of Regulations 18360 and 18361. Both regulations further define our enforcement and administrative proceedings. The use of official titles by individuals in campaigns is not an issue addressed by the Act. Perhaps your local civil prosecutor can assist you with this question.

I hope this information is of assistance to you. Pursuant to your request, your name has been added to our press release mailing list.
