Dear Ms Bunch:

This is a response to the request from the San Diego County Registrar's office regarding the campaign provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").

The San Diego County Registrar's office will be conducting a special election on behalf of the City of Escondido. This letter constitutes written advice under Section 84205.

Section 84205 provides:

"The Commission may by regulation or written advice permit candidates and committees to file campaign statements combining statements and reports required to be filed by this title."

A special election has been called for Proposition A to be voted upon within the City of Escondido on August 17, 1999. For primarily formed committees filing statements in connection with this election, the first pre-election campaign statement required to be filed is due July 8, 1999, and covers the period January 1, 1999 through July 3, 1999. Because the semi-annual statement filing deadline for primarily formed ballot measure committees is July 31, 1999, which falls after the deadline for the first pre-election statement, committees formed to support or oppose the measure should file reports as follows:

1/ The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.

2/ The recipient of a late "in-kind" contribution must file a Late Contribution Report within 48 hours from the time the in-kind contribution is received.

Note:

- Semi-annual and pre-election campaign statements of 30 pages or less may be faxed if the exact original statement is sent within 24 hours of the filing deadline. Late Contribution and Late Independent Expenditure Reports may be faxed but are not also required to be mailed.
