This letter is in response to your request for advice regarding the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ It does not appear from the limited information you provided that you are authorized by the named public officials to request advice. Regulation 18329, copy enclose, provides that the Commission may decline to provide advice where the request is submitted by a third party about another person's duties under the Act.

However, I did want to direct you to the following general information that may relate to your questions:
